



## Work Under Synthesys+ Task 4.3

- Scheduled to end 2020 now extended to July 2021
- Task 4.3: Encourage adoption of IIIF in Natural History Community
  - Task 4.3.1: Exemplar implementations at ten institutions.
    - 7 live deployments
    - 4 deployments nearly live
    - Report will be submitted by end of April.
  - $\circ$  Task 4.3.2: Mechanism to link CETAF IDs to IIIF and back.  $\checkmark$
  - Task 4.3.3: Outreach, in particular a manual on implementation with use experience stories.
    - Next big thing. Starting on this now for delivery in July.
    - Demo application also part of this.



## What comes after Synthesys+

- We have exemplar deployments, a best practice manual and at least one demo application.
- I will continue as IIIF Consortium Ambassador to Natural History community and relationships will continue we hope.
- DiSSCO integration
  - Trivial inclusion of IIIF end points for specimen images.
  - Not so trivial provision of infrastructure for hosting image files.
- Other projects?
  - Thematic portals
  - Common annotation mechanism (W3C compliant).
  - Machine learning for label segmentation at a minimum.
